

**Yard Waste Collection is generally from April through November.**

**Yard Waste Is:** Grass Clippings, Leaves, Shrubbery Trimmings, Garden Debris, Brush Trimmings and Branches (less than 4 inches in diameter and less than 6 feet in length, bundled and tied.)

**Yard Waste DOES NOT Include:** sod, pet waste, branches over 4 inches in diameter, dirt, rocks, trash, root balls.

**Place yard waste at the curb, Six (6) feet from your rubbish in the following manner:**

1. Place yard waste in brown yard waste bags or 30 to 35 gallon cans CLEARLY MARKED "YARD WASTE". DO NOT USE A PLASTIC BAG LINER DO NOT USE PAPER GROCERY BAGS OR BOXES

*Cans over 35-gallons will not be collected due to weight. No container should weigh more than 50 pounds.*

2. Large branches, brush piles are not collected.

3. Bundle brush and branches that are 4 inches in diameter or less in 4-6 foot long bundles tied with string. Please insure bundles are no larger than 18 inches around. Yard waste mixed with rubbish can not be collected.

## SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

### GENERAL REFUSE

Place general refuse (rubbish) in **32-gallon** plastic containers with handles or place in 33 gallon plastic trash bags. No contractor bags. The full container may not exceed **50 pounds**. Please do not mix solid waste with yard waste (compost). **WM** does not collect the following items: commercial or industrial hazardous waste, automobile batteries, roofing and construction debris, vehicle, tires, large auto parts.

## BULK ITEMS

### BULK ITEMS

Residents are allowed to put out two large bulk items per week. For example: appliances, mattress, furniture or hot water heaters. Household refrigerator, humidifiers, and any item containing freon will be collected on the regular trash day.

Household refrigerators need to have the doors removed. Carpet and padding must be cut in four foot sections or smaller, rolled and tied.

**Do not exceed six pieces.** Do not put trash on top of bulk items. Wood must be bundled and tied in 4 foot length. No protruding nails, nails must be removed or flattened. Mattresses must be wrapped in plastic and taped due to bed bug outbreak.
